• Average Daily Membership (ADM) Overview-

Original Budget: 155Final Budget: 152YTD Actual: 152.47

- The school's original budget projects a net income for FY25 of \$89,585, which is a
  projected cumulative fund balance of \$1,059,494 or 37% of total expenditures at fiscal
  year-end.
- The school's final budget projects a net loss for FY25 of -\$188,612.56, which is a projected cumulative fund balance of \$851,296 or 29.04% of total expenditures at fiscal year end.
- Projected Days Cash on Hand for the fiscal year-end is 100 days.

#### **Financial Statement Key Points**

- As of the month end, 92% of the year was complete
- Revenues received at end of the reporting period is at 82.4%
- Expenditures disbursed at end of the reporting period is at 82.9%
- Cash Balance as of the reporting period is \$812,670.60, which is up from the previous month
- The Due From Other Funds on the Balance Sheet will be reimbursed
